Notes: <sup>a</sup>The categories under graduate employment are not mutually exclusive. Therefore some students were counted in more than 1 category. Conversely, several schools under reported the graduate student employment. The students that were not accounted for were categorized in the “other” category. <sup>b</sup>If the school reported the faculty salary as “12 month,” the amount was prorated for 9 months. <sup>c</sup>One school reported 2 degree titles and each title was counted in the respective category. <sup>d</sup>This year’s questionnaire did not ask respondents to answer the “total number of credit hours required for your accredited RCE program.” <sup>e</sup>This question was asked differently last year, and therefore direct comparison may be hindered.
